To login you will need to enter your name (as shown at the top of your email) and your child's name ([First Name] [Last Name]). The login details you enter must match those we have on record for you.

Appointments will be available to book from 12:00 on 23rd Oct 2024 until 18:00 on 5th Nov 2024.

After you have made your appointments you can choose to print or e-mail confirmation.

If you cannot login please contact the school office.

N.B. The email address field on the login page is only used to send your appointment confirmation. If you have problems logging in, it will not be because of the e-mail address you entered.
