### Inspire 2024 – Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024

We are delighted that our Year 3 and 4 children have been invited to take part in this year's Inspire visits to Lichfield Cathedral. Through a range of workshops and activities, the children will engage with the concepts of spirituality, well-being, and courageous advocacy, as well as exploring the beautiful Cathedral. As the pupils engage with each of the interactive stations, they will explore what each element means for people of faith as well as what it means for us as we develop an awareness of these in our everyday lives.

The children will travel by coach and, traffic dependent, should return to school for normal collection at the end of the day. We will send a text to inform parents if the coach is going to be late returning. Children should wear their school uniform. Please be aware that the cathedral is cold inside, even on a hot day, so children will need a jumper / cardigan or fleece. Hats and headwear are not allowed except for religious purposes.

If your child is eligible for benefit related Free School Meals, they are entitled to a packed lunch provided by school. Please order this via the Gateway app by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Alternatively, you can send them with a home packed lunch and drink in a backpack. (No fizzy drinks, sweets or items obviously containing nuts).

The total cost of this visit is £15.20 per child to cover the entrance and transport. However, the school have subsidised this cost by £5.20 per child, reducing the amount payable by parents to £10.00 per child. Children eligible for benefit related Free School Meals have been subsidised by school a further £2.00, reducing their payment to £8.00 per child.



Whilst payment is voluntary, we do rely on enough parental support to make the trip viable and enable it to go ahead. The cost to the school budget is already £366.00. Should sufficient parental contributions not be received, the trip will unfortunately be cancelled.

If you wish your child to participate, please give consent via the Gateway app and pay by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Children are not able to participate in the trip without consent. If you have any concerns regarding payment, please contact the office or see Mrs Ferretti.
