

Please spread the word - everyone is welcome!





Adverse Weather

Whilst we might be looking forward to warmer weather and a bit of sunshine, there is still the possibility of snow in the half term ahead! If we do experience any severe snowfall in the coming weeks, we will endeavour to operate normally wherever possible. Any closures will be in exceptional circumstances and be made in the interests of health and safety. A school closure could be directed by the Local Authority which would mean that all maintained schools in the city must close. Alternatively, a local school closure may be necessary due to conditions specifically around our school.

Should a decision to close be made across all schools, information will be shared on the "Wolverhampton Today" Facebook page, the City of Wolverhampton Council's Twitter feed and on the City of Wolverhampton Council's Website.

If there is no definite announcement about Wolverhampton schools by 7:30am, it can be assumed that there has not been a general closure.

As a school, we will send a text message to all parents as soon as a decision to close is taken (either by the LA or by school.). We will also post the closure on our Facebook page.

Where possible, we will give as much notice as possible. I am sure however, you can appreciate that forecasts can be unpredictable and there are times when the weather can take us somewhat by surprise!

Thursday Week 2 - Chicken Curry and Sweet & Sour Noodles has been replaced with Cottage Pie.


Tuesday Week 3 - Chilli / Enchiladas has been replaced with Hot Dogs and Fries


