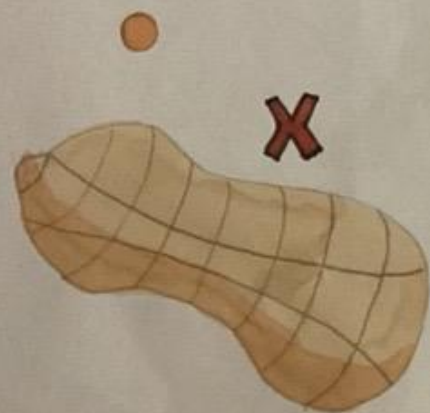

# anaphylaxis



Symptoms: Rapid onset, Affects Airway breathing and circulation, Rash, Flushed and swelling, sudden collapse, Stomach pain or Discomfort, Nausea and vomiting, Feeling faint or weak, sense of impending doom/panic.



## MORE INFORMATION:

Anaphylaxis is a severe, life-threatening allergic reaction. It can happen seconds or minutes after you've been exposed to something you are allergic to.
