Dear Parents/Carers

As you know, children in Year 6 are required to complete Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in May. These tests will assess each child's attainment in Reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG) and Maths (Arithmetic and Reasoning). Children will also receive a teacher assessment judgement in Maths and Science.

Tests are based on the curriculum content taught throughout Key Stage Two and in class, they regularly practise and consolidate these skills. It is important that children don't feel stressed or anxious about their SATs – all we ask them to do is to try their best! To help them prepare for their SATs and feel confident to demonstrate all that they know and can do, we are delighted to be able to offer them some additional support and consolidation through an afterschool club.

Starting next week (**Monday 4th March**), the club will run on Mondays and Tuesdays, led by Mr Davis-Powell. Each session will provide additional practise and application of both Maths and English skills.

If collecting your child, please come to the pedestrian gate at 4pm. If your child has consent to walk home alone, they will be dismissed by staff from the pedestrian gate at 4pm.

If you would like your child to take part, please confirm and give consent via the Gateway app.
